DOUBLES LEAGUE RULES

1. All matches must start within 15 minutes of the scheduled starting time. A team not having its players present after 30 minutes shall forfeit the game/games relevant to the absent player as they fall due. In the event of the match being incomplete due to the lateness of players the uncompleted games should be forfeited.
2. A team shall consist of four players listed on the result sheet in order of strength. Each player in a team will play two games with each of the other team players as shown. Games need not be played in the order shown above.
3. All matches shall be played to 12 games of 21 points using the Rally Points system, with EXTENDED PLAY allowed up to 30 POINTS
4. Feather shuttlecocks shall be used in all League and Cup Matches. The make of shuttlecock used shall be at the discretion of the home team provided they conform to regulation speed.
5. Re-arrangement of matches is allowed before the second Saturday in September provided that the Association Match Secretary is notified of the change. After this, re-arrangement will only be allowed in exceptional circumstances after consultation with the Association Match Secretary. Non-availability of players is not a valid reason for re-arrangement.
6. A player can only represent one club during the season. Only bona-fide club members can play in matches. All members must be affiliated to the appropriate County Association and Badminton England.
7. Club's with more than one team must nominate the players of each, except the lowest team, to the Association Match Secretary before any team plays their first match. The eligibility of these nominated players shall previously have been ascertained and their assent obtained.
8. Rules on the interchange of players between teams in a club are as follows -
 - (a) Nominated players are not allowed to play for a lower team.
 - (b) A player's lower team status is forfeit if they play more than three league matches for higher teams.
 - (c) Where a club wishes to relegate a nominated player to a lower team, this can only be done on application to the Association Match Secretary and with Association Committee approval.
 - (d) There are no restrictions on Junior League players playing in the Doubles League.
 - (e) For the Ladies Doubles League only; No more than 2 nominated 'A' team players from the Senior League Division 1 may play in any Ladies Doubles League match.
9. League points are awarded to each team as per the number of games won.
10. All matches must be completed by the end of April.
