### WESSEX CUP RULES

1. All matches must start within 15 minutes of the scheduled starting time. A team not having its players present after 30 minutes shall forfeit the game/games relevant to the absent player as they fall due. In the event of the match being incomplete due to the lateness of players the uncompleted games should be forfeited.
2. Team pairings shall be in order of strength and exchanged before the match commences.
3. All matches shall be played to 18 games of 21 points using the Rally Points system, but with **NO EXTENDED PLAY**.
4. Feather shuttlecocks shall be used in all Wessex Cup matches. The make of shuttlecock used shall be at the discretion of the home team provided they conform to regulation speed.
5. First round matches may be arranged at the fixture meeting. Winners of each round who have a home tie in the next will be notified of their opponents, and these must be contacted within three days of notification to arrange the tie before the closing date of the round. The Wessex Cup Secretary should be notified if there is any difficulty in arranging a mutually acceptable date.
6. A player can only represent one club during the season. Only bona-fide club members can play in matches. All members must be affiliated to the appropriate County Association and Badminton England.
7. Team nominations for the Senior League will also apply in Wessex Cup matches.
8. Rules on the interchange of players between teams in a club in Wessex Cup matches are as follows -
  - (a) Nominated players are not allowed to play for a lower team.
  - (b) A player's lower team status is forfeit if they play more than three league matches for higher teams.
  - (c) Where a club wishes to relegate a nominated player to a lower team, this can only be done on application to the Association Match Secretary and with Association Committee approval.
  - (d) A player's status in the Senior League is not affected by any matches played in the Wessex Cup, and vice versa.
